Sandpaper.

We have in stock now a range of grades of Carborundum Dry Lube and Waterproof sanding sheets. Grades start at 80 grit and go through to 2000 grit. This is the same paper we have been using in our own workshop for several years with great results. These papers cut well, don't clog too rapidly and seem to last well. If you are using the Organoll Hardburnishing Oil (what else is there????) then the wet and dry is the go. You will get excellent results if you work your way through to 800 grit but go on to 1200 and 2000 grit for a truly amazing finish. At Monaro Timber we can now fix you up with the timber, glue, oil and now the paper to sand it. Stay tuned for the next edition to the range of products on offer to help you get through the job.

Klindex Floor Sanders

I recently attended a demo afternoon at the MBA building on Northbourne Ave. On show were the range of Klindex floor sanders used and distributed in the ACT area by Diadex Flooring Systems. These machines are about to revolutionise floor sanding and have the potential to save you professional floor sanders piles of money. These machines can sand within 10mm of skirtings, can cross cut hallways, have a unique extraction system which is virtually dust free and by changing the head

you can undertake floor prep such as concrete grinding. I'm told the machine will not make coffee but this may be an inclusion on future models.
