Last month I mentioned we had good stocks of Tas Oak. Check out these flooring rates.

85 x 19 select	\$56.00 / m ²
85 x 19 standard	\$48.50 / m ²
85 x 13 select	\$44.00 / m ²
85 x 13 standard	\$38.50 / m ²

This material is all excellent quality. The 19mm boards are end matched whilst the 13mm overlay is plain end. If you are looking for a floor that provides light yet warm tones then this is the one. All prices include GST. Come in and check it out.

New Stock

We have stocks of Brush Box and Jarrah flooring on hand. The Box in particular is not always easy to get so if you are thinking about some then now is the time. I have more 25mm and 38mm rough sawn Box due shortly too so if you are chasing steps etc we will be able to accommodate you. Recently arrived is a stock of feature grade 150 x 25mm Jarrah. This grade has more gum vein and pin hole borer than the select grade and comes at a cheaper rate. We recently ran skirtings and flooring in feature Red Box and Yellow Box. Tough stuff but it looked fantastic when it was laid. Feature grades can be just the thing in the right job.

Other new stocks include Danta in several sizes, 38 and 50mm Jarrah, Mixed Hardwood decking and more. I have also received some weatherboard samples in Cypress Pine, Iron Bark and Yellow Stringybark. They look great, especially with an oil finish. We can also do Stringy decking in 32mm thick. For a bullet proof deck, this is the way to go.
