## New Stock.

Even though I have been trying to reduce stock purchases before our move we still managed to buy in a heap of new timber. Two new packs of 100 x 100 Jarrah arrived the other day. We have just pulled an order from it but there is plenty left over. We also received a pack of 125 x 38 Jarrah and a pack of 200 x 38. It was all good looking stuff. Recently a new pack of 150 x 25 Blackwood turned up and we are waiting on some thicker material to arrive.

Are you chasing an appearance grade structural hardwood? We have several options including our newest addition, Keruing. This timber is a very clean medium / dark brown hardwood that is rated F27 in strength and is a class one durability species. Not only can you use it for joists on a deck but it would make fantastic handrails and even outdoor furniture. Best of all, the prices are normal structural rates, not appearance grade prices.

On the flooring front, we have good stocks of Tas Oak in most sizes including 133 x 19. We have also received some Brush Box and Jarrah flooring recently. I have received stock lists from several north coast mills listing a number of sizes available in a broad range of species. We have feature grade 130 x 19 in a number of species available at \$46.00 / m<sup>2</sup>.
