Shortly we will have a greater selection of veneered board on hand and of course if we don't have it available we can always get it in quickly. Any day our new orders racks will be assembled so collection of orders will be much simpler. Back in, load up and go. ( pay first! ) Our new racks for dressed and figured products are just about done too so this will make quite a difference. Our shelf units are in and being stocked with oils, adhesives and papers.

### Correction.

Back in May I featured Spotted Gum and told you all about this fantastic timber. I also told you its botanical name is *Corymbia citriodora*. *Citriodora* is the Lemon Scented Spotted Gum and *Corymbia maculata* is the one we generally carry. There is one more, *Corymbia henryi* which is the large-leaf Spotted Gum. Thanks very much to Terry for pointing out the error. In 1995 these timbers were re-classified from the *Eucalyptus* genus to the *Corymbia* genus and when I wrote the piece in May I failed to read my resource material closely enough. Good thing some of you are on the ball.

Due to a number of factors our demo evening on the Kleiberit flooring glue has been delayed and will happen sometime soon. Meanwhile, we now have stock so if you need flooring glue talk to us.

## New Stock.

With the move and the lead up to the end of the financial year I thought I would let stocks drop a bit. Fat chance. Managed to buy in quite a bit last month!! We saw new stocks of 150 x 38 clear Hoop Pine and we moved two packs of 25mm Hoop from storage into the racks. A lot of Yellow Stringy Bark decking came and went too but we still have stocks of 65mm available. The mill advises more 85mm decking won't be available until August / September. The good news on the decking front is that we have heaps of 64 and 88mm mixed hardwood available which is made up mostly of Spotted Gum and Iron Bark. We also have one pack of 136 x 19 decking in Iron Bark sitting in the store with more available in Queensland.

A pack of 125 x 38 Blackwood arrived just a few days ago. As with all of our Blackwood in recent times it is excellent quality with great colour. We are well stocked with Danta, most sizes of Jarrah, Tas Oak and Ash and many of the other popular timbers. Nearly forgot to mention we received fresh Rock Maple and Euro Beech recently too. The Keruing I mentioned last month has proven to be a winner finding its way into all sorts of projects from joists to hand rails, steps and outdoor furniture. And why not? It's very good value being and appearance grade product for structural type prices.
