



Liberon finishing products.

We took over the distributorship in the ACT for Liberon products a couple of months ago. If you had a look at our newsletter from a couple of issues back you might remember us announcing this. So far so good with these products but I must say we have been on a steep learning curve. There are a large number of items in the full range which are capable of performing all manner of jobs. Fortunately Liberon Head Office is always on hand to answer any technical questions if we aren't sure.

The range includes a large selection of coloured wax filler sticks for fixing up minor cracks, gum veins etc. You simply work into the problem area then scrape off the excess. The wax dries hard to produce a very fast and effective repair. We also have a range of other fillers for larger jobs. If you use shellac we have this too now. Shellac is the basis of the traditional French polishing technique and is excellent for furniture restoration or those who seek the depth this finish can provide.

Other products in the range include several different oils, Gilt creams for picture frame finishes, a large range of coloured polishing waxes for finishing and rejuvenating furniture, tack clothes for removing contaminants during the finishing process and various water and oil based stains. There are more products that I've either forgotten about or don't have on the shelf at present. If you require something we don't have please call and we can get it in. This usually takes only a day to do. And the best bit.

We can get 140 x 25 Spotted Gum and the mill is running 135 x 30 Blackbutt in a few weeks. We stock 90 x 90 KD laminated Merbau for posts. Thinking treated pine for the sub frame? Do yourself a favour and go KD hardwood or Cypress. Heaps stronger and no chemical. Other new stocks to arrive include 25mm White Oak, various Jarrah sizes, a selection of Tas Oak, various Sydney Blue Gum sizes and some 38mm Brush Box. Coming soon is a selection of super wide boards in Maple and other species. Check them out, early May.
