Log Shield.

Currently available in 20 Lt drums. We will have 5 Lt drums shortly. What is it? It's a wax emulsion for sealing the ends of timber, logs etc. It can go on green or dry timber and helps reduce end cracking. Log Shield takes over from the old Mobil Cer—M which is no longer available. We now distribute this product as the only other way to get it is to buy a pallet of 44 gallon drums from the manufacturer!! Ask us for a data sheet.

Timberlay Flooring

A while back I wrote about the Timberlay flooring from Australian Solar Timbers (AST). This is a fantastic product that gives you the look and feel of a traditional timber floor but it is only 12mm thick. It's really starting to take off because it has a number of great advantages.

Being only 12mm thick it is not a structural product. That means it needs to be fully supported underneath by either plywood or particleboard flooring. It is still a solid timber floorboard, not a floating floor, and gains it's height advantage by using a small tongue which is located down low on the board, essentially giving the same amount of timber above the tongue as a traditional 19mm board. This means long life. Being a thinner board it can be cut from a different resource. This resource is cheaper so Timberlay is very price competitive. It comes in lengths from 500mm to 2700mm and is bundled in lots of around 16Lm. This makes carrying it into the house, or more importantly up stairs or elevators, much easier than the 19mm option. There are a number of north coast hardwood species available including Blue Gum, Blackbutt, Mixed Reds and Whites, Tallowwood and Brush Box.

We still have the AST display in our yard. It is going back to them shortly but it's worth checking out if you are looking at a hardwood floor.
