## Yes, we are moving!!

The rumours are true. Monaro Timber is moving. After seven and a half years in Townsville St and for me personally, seventeen years in the same building. It's been a good ride but just like the fun parks, you finish one ride then you move on to the next. We've got a great one coming up!!

Our new home will be in Kealman Road, Queanbeyan. For you Canberra based people, don't panic. Queanbeyan isn't that far away and in fact we are just four minutes from the DFO. It takes longer than that to drive through Fyshwick sometimes. We will have a bigger premises with much larger office space and a super sized showroom. There are many exciting benefits for us and our customers with this move. For me, I get an office that isn't in the kitchen!

The move starts in a few weeks. We will have a brief workshop shutdown between July 20 and July 24. If all goes to plan, and we do have a very detailed plan, the timber sales side of our business won't be shutting at all but it may be spread over two sites for a few weeks. We will try very hard not to inconvenience you any more than we have too. The move should be complete by the end of August as we are due to be out of our current place by then. On that note, if you are looking for a good building then let me know as the future of the buildings we are in hasn't been confirmed. There are two, each covering 696m<sup>2</sup> plus yard. Both are up for lease and at least one is open to offers for a sale.

## Machinery for sale.

At the moment we have a number of woodwork machines for sale. There are several from Monaro Timber and from one of our customers. ## New Silkwood flooring.

Last month I told you about the Big River engineered flooring. We also carry the Silkwood from Boral and

they have introduced a new 175mm wide single plank board. Wide board flooring has become more popular in recent times and the Silkwood is now available in this super wide board in three timbers. Blue Gum, Brush Box and Blackbutt. Some of the other products are being phased out and there are a few specials going so if you are looking for some extra savings talk to us.

## Specials and current stock.

We have had a few packs in the last month. Stocks of Merbau decking are good and we have had another pack of 64 x 19 Grey Ironbark decking in too. On the furniture timbers front, we have seen several packs of Jarrah arrive in 25 and 38mm. New stocks of Sapelle Mahogany came in too. Generally stocks of our other cabinet timbers are good too and in fact we have a few specials so we save moving some boards to Queanbeyan. We have up to 40% off the following timbers.
